

The parties shall abide by the following *Behavioral Order* in place of any further protective orders:

- a. There shall be no abusive telephone calls to either party.
- b. There shall be no name calling.
- c. There shall be no foul language.
- d. Both parties shall avoid conflicts/contacts with the other party's "significant other."
- e. Neither party shall use the child or children as a weapon against the other parent.
- f. There shall be no harassment at places of employment.
- g. There shall be no copies of letters to anyone associated with a party.
- h. There shall be no phone calls to other people associated with the other party.
- i. Both parties' focus is to remain on the best interest of the children.
- j. Both parties shall maintain respect towards the other party's relatives and friends.
- k. Each party shall advise all of his/her friends, relatives and significant others, (if any) not to disparage, criticize or harass the other party.
- l. Child custody exchanges, visitations, etc. shall be done in a civil, law abiding manner and reasonably close to the times specified by the Court.
- m. There shall be no threats of violence or harm to any other party, any other relative and/or friends of any party.
- n. Neither party shall interrogate the children as to the activities or events at the other parent's residence, etc. and shall try to respect the child's privacy and relationship with the other parent.
- o. In the event of an emergency or unforeseen circumstance that could affect an exchange of the child or the time of the exchange, a party shall call or contact the other party as soon as is reasonably possible.
